NEWTON - The investigation into a Conover man's involvement in opium trafficking that authorities think led to the murder of his family is out of the hands of the Catawba County Sheriff's Office.

Brian Tzeo's wife, two daughters and son were killed in their home March 12.

The investigation went federal last week, said Chief Deputy Coy Reid of the sheriff's office. A federal task force is handling the investigation, he said, but he is uncertain if the Drug Enforcement Administration or the FBI will lead the investigation.

Tzeo has been in California since March 20 attending to the burial of his wife, Lisa Phan, 40, and children, Melanie, 20, Pauline, 18, and Cody, 4, who were discovered shot and stabbed to death in their Bunker Hill-area home on Gristmill Drive.

Thirty-seven-year-old **Chiew Chan Saevang**, of Schofield, Wis., entered Tzeo's home through an unlocked door and killed Tzeo's wife and the couple's three children, authorities said.

The investigation by Catawba County sheriff's investigators led authorities to Utah, where Washington County sheriff's deputies spotted Saevang and Yer Yang in a BMW on Interstate 15 and engaged in a high-speed chase that ended when Saevang wrecked the car and killed himself and Yang.

Illegal alien gets 11yrs for forcible rape and molestation of 13 & 14 yr olds

10 arrested during ICE-led operation in Concord targeting gang members

CONCORD, NC - Ten foreign-born gang members and associates with ties to local violent street gangs were arrested here yesterday following a U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) led operation. The operation, dubbed Community Shield, was a multi-agency effort spearheaded by ICE. Among the participating agencies were the Cabarrus County Sheriff's Office, Concord Police Department, Charlotte Mecklenburg Police Department and the North Carolina Department of Crime Control and Public Safety's Alcohol Law (NC-ALE)

The operation targeted foreign-born members and associates of MS-13 and Brown Pride street gangs.

Of those arrested, nine are nationals of Mexico and one from El Salvador. All of them were found to be illegally present in the United States and are now in ICE custody; however, two of them, although administratively arrested, were remanded to State custody due to criminal offenses that include narcotics violations and obstruction of justice. ICE will begin removal proceedings on all of them.

"Public safety is a significant part of ICE's role in protecting the homeland, but it is also a shared law enforcement mission," said Delbert Richburg, assistant special agent in charge of ICE's Office of Investigations in Charlotte. "ICE works closely with other federal, state, and local law enforcement partners to keep our communities safe, which in this case is the removal of criminal gang members and others who threaten the safety of Brockton neighborhoods."

Transnational gangs pose a growing public safety threat to communities throughout the country. It is estimated that there are more 900 different gangs in the United States. These gangs no longer own turf in just the inner city but have spread their criminal networks throughout suburban and rural communities.

These transnational street gangs have a significant number of foreign-born members and are frequently involved in human and contraband smuggling, immigration violations and other crimes. Like any street gang, these transnational gangs also have a propensity toward violence. Their members commit a myriad crimes including robbery, extortion, assault, rape and murder.

Operation Community Shield is an ongoing national initiative in which ICE partners with other federal, state and local law enforcement agencies to address the significant public safety threat posed by transnational street gangs. Partnerships with local law enforcement agencies are

essential to the success of the initiative, and they help further ensure officer safety during the operations.

Since ICE began Operation Community Shield in February 2005, more than 12,200 gang members belonging to more than 700 different gangs have been arrested nationwide.

SSS Student Caught With Knife On Campus

A student at Smithfield Selma High School was arrested on campus Thursday and charged with having a knife in his possession. **Julio Dejesus Limon**, 16, of Zebulon was charged with possession of a weapon on educational property by school resource officers. Officers said Limon attracted their attention because he wasn't in class and was in an area of campus he wasn't suppose to be. Limon later posted a \$1,000 bond and was released from custody. In addition to the criminal charges, Limon could also face disciplinary action from the Johnston County School system, including possible suspension, according to the Code of Conduct policy.

Drugs Seized From Princeton Home

Narcotic agents with the Johnston County Sheriff's Office seized 20 grams of suspected marijuana after searching a home on Rock Well Lane in Princeton Thursday night. Officers responded to the residence after receiving several complaints about alleged illegal drug activity at the residence, according to sheriff's office spokesperson Tammy Amaon. In addition to the narcotics, drug paraphernalia was also reportedly found. **Michael S. Salazar**, 22, of Princeton and **Eric Duran Sanchez**, 20, of Lucama were arrested and charged with felony possession with intent to manufacture, sell and deliver marijuana, possession of drug paraphernalia, and maintaining a dwelling to keep a controlled substance. Both suspects were placed in the Johnston County Jail in lieu of a \$21,000 bond each.

Man Charged With Pointing Gun At Smithfield Woman

A man who allegedly pointed a gun at a Smithfield woman during a domestic altercation Thursday night on Kaye Drive is facing charges. The 33 year-old victim said she awoke to find the suspect in her bedroom. During a confrontation outside the home, the suspect identified as 28 year-old **Aquil Mohammed Alhej** of Dunn allegedly pointed a gun at the victim and communicated threats. Alhej was arrested a short time later during a traffic stop in Dunn. He was charged with several offenses including assault on a female, assault by pointing a gun, and communicating threats. Police said the victim in the case was Alhej's ex-girlfriend.

Illegal Resident Convicted Of Distributing Drugs, Money Laundering

A Newton Grove resident will be spending the next 12 years behind bars following his sentencing in federal court in Raleigh last week. **Julian Avilez-Lopez**, 32, who was in the

US illegally, had previously pled guilty to conspiring to distribute more than 5 kilos of cocaine and well as money laundering. Avilez-Lopez was the main target of an organized crime task force during an operation dubbed *Northern Star*. *Northern Star* targeted mid- to upper-level drug traffickers in Sampson, Wayne, and Lenoir Counties. Avilez-Lopez and his associates, prosecutors said, were responsible for importing and distributing hundreds of kilos of powder cocaine and other narcotics then laundering the proceeds of the drug sales. The suspect used the Tienda Avilez convenience store in Newton Grove as a base for the drug trafficking operation. As part of his plea, Avilez-Lopez forfeited several pieces of property in Sampson County.

Charlotte becomes heroin hub

City key spoke in Mexican drug rings

CHARLOTTE, N.C. -- Mexican drug traffickers have turned Charlotte into a key distribution point for "black tar" heroin in North Carolina, according to the Justice Department.

Heroin-related arrests have jumped. And while officials have not seen an increase in drug-related violence, they worry that could change.

The U.S. Department of Justice's 2009 National Drug Threat Assessment identified Charlotte as one of 230 cities where Mexican traffickers "maintain drug distribution networks" to sell cocaine, marijuana, methamphetamines and heroin.

John Emerson, assistant special agent in charge for the N.C. bureau of the U.S. Drug Enforcement Administration, would say only that "multiple" cells operate in Charlotte, but at least three have been shut down in the past two years.

One was run out of a small house on quiet Mary Jo Helms Drive until it was busted last year. **Israel Hernandez**, 21, ran a nearly million-dollar business from the family neighborhood, preparing black tar and dispatching couriers to deliver it to suburban customers waiting outside public places like Office Depot and Walgreens.

In September 2007, authorities arrested seven men and seized \$114,000 and 24,000 doses of heroin hidden in the garage of a southwest Charlotte house less than two miles from Steele Creeke Elementary.

In another investigation, dubbed Operation Black Gold Rush, federal and local authorities busted **Jairo Nunez**, 27, for leading 13 people in a Charlotte black tar ring. The same organization was also active in South Carolina, Tennessee, Indiana, California, Ohio and Arizona.

Charlotte has one of the country's fastest growing immigrant populations. An estimated 390,000 illegal immigrants live in North Carolina, according to the Pew Hispanic Center.

While most immigrants are not involved in drug trafficking, federal authorities say the growing Latino community allows traffickers to blend into the community and conceal their activities.

Adams, the CMPD captain, likened the Mexican drug organizations to a Fortune 500 company. They have managers and distribution supervisors. They have strict rules and keep detailed budgets, including planning for annual losses.

At the time of his arrest, Hernandez made \$2,000 to \$7,000 a day delivering heroin, according to court records.

"It's a business," Adams said. "To them it's about money. It's all about the money."

20 Pounds Of Marijuana Confiscated

A Lillington man is under arrest for trafficking a large amount of marijuana after an undercover operation by the Harnett County Sheriff's Office. **Juan Jaimez Rodriguez**, 21, is charged with trafficking more than 20 pounds of marijuana. Rodriguez was arrested after the execution of a search warrant at the home on Eric Thomas Road. An arrest report said

the sheriff's office seized 9,178 grams of imported marijuana from a 1994 Toyota Camry Rodriguez was driving. Rodriguez, a legal resident with Mexican citizenship, is charged with trafficking by possession and trafficking by transportation. He was held under \$150,000 bond.

Cocaine, Cash Seized In Wayne County

The Goldsboro-Wayne County Drug Squad confiscated more than two ounces of powder cocaine during a traffic stop Thursday night on Highway 581 near US70. \$673 in cash was also seized. **Alfredo Lucinao Jaramillo**, 27, of Goldsboro was charged with two counts of trafficking a controlled substance and maintaining a vehicle for the sale of a controlled substance. Jaramillo was held in the Wayne County Jail under a \$100,000 bond.

Woman charged in fatal accident

A man riding a motorcycle was killed Sunday afternoon in a wreck in downtown Burlington.

The wreck happened at the intersection of South Church Street and Davis streets.

William Bryan Barber, 43, died at the scene of the wreck, police said. An unidentified juvenile passenger riding on the motorcycle was hurt and was taken by helicopter to Duke University Medical Center. The juvenile passenger was reported to be in stable condition.

Police said the accident happened about 3 p.m.

Police accounts say the wreck happened when **Lidia Monica Lopez**, 41, was traveling east on South Church Street and the 1995 Dodge pickup truck she was driving collided with a 1990 Dodge driven by Pamela Coble and with the motorcycle driven by Barber.

Lopez was charged with misdemeanor death by motor vehicle, driving with no operator's license and running a red light. She was released from Alamance Regional Medical Center after being treated there.

Coble, 60, was driven to Alamance Regional Medical Center and treated at the hospital.

Assistant Chief Greg Seel said he had limited information on the wreck. He wasn't sure where Barber lived.

Bond for Lopez was set at \$10,000, according to records at the county jail. Jail records also indicate she can't be released if she posts bond because she is in the country illegally.

LEXINGTON — Two Greensboro men were arrested Saturday in Davidson County after deputies found 21 pounds of marijuana.

Both men were charged with trafficking marijuana and possession of drug paraphernalia and are being held in the Davidson County jail on bonds of \$1 million each.

CHARLOTTE, N.C. — An illegal immigrant has been sentenced to 24 years in prison after prosecutors say he trafficked two teenage girls in North Carolina to perform sex acts.

Prosecutors said testimony from Tuesday's sentencing hearing found that 44-year-old **Jorge Flores-Rojas** trafficked a 16-year-old girl between Washington and Charlotte in 2007. They said he repeatedly sexually and physically abused the girl.

Prosecutors said he also trafficked a 17-year-old girl and an adult woman from North Carolina to Washington. They said Flores-Rojas had previously paid other people to smuggle the victims from Mexico into the United States.

Flores-Rojas pleaded guilty in October. He will be deported to Mexico upon release from prison.

Deputies make several arrests in gang graffiti case

Ten people, including two minors, face several charges for allegedly spray painting gang graffiti on two different buildings.

On Sunday, deputies with the Alamance County Sheriff's Department received a report that two men were spray painting the facade of Crabtree Services Co., located at the intersection of Monroe Holt Road and N.C. 49 South, according to a news release.

While investigating that incident, deputies received a second call about spray painting at a nearby mobile home park off N.C. 49. When they arrived, they saw "several Hispanic males run from the scene."

After interviewing the driver of a car that officers had spotted at both locations, officers arrested eight people and took juvenile petitions against two minors.

The two minors and seven of the eight adults were confirmed members of the **Tarasco 13 gang**, a gang from the Raleigh area, according to the release.

Henderson slaying suspect was recently paroled

Records show violent past, recent release for man

HENDERSONVILLE – A suspect charged with the brutal slaying and robbery of a Henderson County man spent more than 14 years in prison for violent crimes before his release in September.

Steven R. Ramirez, 33, was convicted of armed robbery in 1994 in Rutherford County, according to N.C. Department of Correction records.

After finishing his sentence on that conviction in 2004, Ramirez immediately began serving another sentence on a 1995 conviction in Henderson County of assault with a deadly weapon inflicting serious injury.

Ramirez could have served up to 10 years on the latter conviction, but was released on parole on Sept. 3 of last year, records show. He also was convicted in 1993 in Henderson County of misdemeanor contributing to the delinquency of a minor.

Ramirez had just turned 19 when he was convicted of the armed robbery charge, according to state prison records.

17-year-old charged with DWI after deputy chase

Fuquay-Varina, N.C. — Three 17-year-olds were arrested Tuesday morning after allegedly leading a Wake County sheriff's deputy on a pursuit from Fuquay-Varina to Holly Springs.

Man shot by deputy is charged

PITTSBORO -- A Staley man who was shot by a Chatham County sheriff's deputy during a drug raid this month has been charged with assaulting a law enforcement officer with a deadly weapon and other felonies.

Jose Gomez Miranda, 34, of 75 Irene Lane, Staley, is being held in prison in lieu of an \$800,000 secured bond, according to the Chatham County Sheriff's office.

Miranda was charged April 18 after being released from UNC Hospitals. He was taken there April 13 after he was shot while the sheriff's Special Incident Response Team and Narcotics Unit was searching a mobile home in Staley.

Police said an unidentified deputy fired several shots when the officers encountered a man, later identified as Miranda, with a handgun.

Deputies seized several kilograms of narcotics from the home, according to the sheriff's office.

Miranda was charged with several felonies, including assault on a law enforcement officer with a deadly weapon and manufacturing cocaine.

The sheriff's office has asked the State Bureau of Investigation to investigate the April 13 shooting to determine whether the deputy acted appropriately.

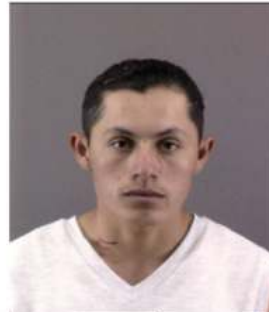

Cocaine Distributor Given 14 Year Prison Sentence

A 26 year-old man will be 40 years old before he is released from prison after his conviction for distributing cocaine in the Duplin and Sampson county areas. **Ruben Borja** of Warsaw distributed narcotics between 2003 and 2005 as part of a Mexican nationals group. Borja worked with a cousin, who authorities said was a local drug trafficker, and Texas drug sources to import and distribute large quantities of drugs. Federal prosecutors said Borja distributed 1,800 kilograms of cocaine and 27 grams of meth. Borja had been a fugitive until his arrest in October 2008. He was sentenced to 168 months in prison following by 5 years of probation. The investigation into the case was conducted by the DEA along with the Sampson and Duplin County Sheriff's Departments.

Mendez**, 21, was charged with felony cockfighting and misdemeanor cruelty to animals. Dunn Police Chief B.P. Jones said he believed he knew what Mr. Mendez was up to. "I have an idea what he was doing was practicing, having those chickens practice fighting each other," he said. "Later on, he was going to go somewhere and have betting." Chief Jones said cockfighting is common practice in Mexico. Currently, animal control officials are housing both game chickens as well as two hens that were captured at the scene. All four chickens have been given names by the animal control officers. The two males are Nugget and Pot Pie while the females are Noodle and Dumplin'. Drug suspects face deportation

Nash County deputies on Saturday arrested **Augustin Renteria** and **Jesus Ortiz Rodriguez**, both of Wilson, after allegedly discovering 221 grams of cocaine and more than \$1,500 inside Rodriguez's car.

The men were stopped during a traffic checkpoint on N.C. 58. A consensual search lead deputies to the cocaine stash, officials said. Afterward, both men confessed to being illegal immigrants from Mexico, deputies said.

Renteria, 22, and Rodriguez, 47, each were arrested and charged with one count of conspiracy to traffic cocaine and multiple counts of cocaine trafficking.

Under federal policy, the sheriff's department is required to notify officials from U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement in the U.S. Department of Homeland Security if they charge an illegal immigrant with a crime. Regardless of whether they are convicted on the charges, Renteria and Rodriguez will be placed on a retainer and deported after court proceedings are complete and once they serve any possible sentence.

"We run a check on every person who runs through our system if they are foreign born," Lt. Pat Joyner said. "Based on that, we'll get a hit from ICE if they are illegal. We run the check on everyone (who is born in another country), though."

Deputies also charged Rodriguez in connection with a March drug violation where officials said 56 grams of cocaine was seized.

The arrests were part of a joint effort between the Nash and Wilson counties sheriff's offices, and the Wilson Police Department.

Both men were taken to the Nash County jail, where they are being held under \$500,000 secure bonds.

Warsaw drug dealer sentenced to 14 years in prison

A 26-year-old Warsaw man who had been a fugitive has been sentenced to 14 years in prison followed by five years supervised release after he was convicted of conspiring to distribute cocaine.

Ruben Borja pleaded guilty in December 2008 to distributing more than five kilograms of cocaine as part of a network of Mexican nationals in Duplin and Sampson counties who participated in cocaine, crack, marijuana and methamphetamine trafficking from 2003 to 2005, according to the U.S. Attorney's Office. Borja was sentenced in a New Bern federal court on Thursday.

The network consisted of two distribution cells. Borja worked as a local drug trafficker from January 2004 until October 2005, according to a news release. Borja worked both cells, and authorities determined he distributed 1,800 kilograms of cocaine and nearly 30 grams of methamphetamine, the news release states.

After Borja's initial arrest in October 2005, he became a fugitive until Oct. 3, 2008 when he was arrested again.

Authorities foil kidnapping ring

Authorities continue to investigate a recent drug-related kidnapping and ransom standoff that resulted in a statewide effort to rescue a Rocky Mount man and bring down at least four people suspected of working for Mexican drug dealers.

The events that culminated Friday night with the arrests of two kidnapping suspects and the rescue of victim Angel Mendoza-Valdovinos were more excitement than Nash County Sheriff Dick Jenkins would like to deal with on a regular basis, he said.

SBI officers stopped **Javier Vera Gonzales**, 27, and **Rivera Jaimes Rigoberto**, 30, around 11 p.m. Friday in Eastern Wake County while the men were en route to a police-staged ransom exchange. Mendoza-Valdovinos was restrained in the suspects' vehicle.

Both Gonzales and Rigoberto were arrested, and each faces one count of first-degree kidnapping, extortion and felony conspiracy.

Jenkins said the two men were posing as officers when they kidnapped Mendoza-Valdovinos from his home on Langwood Way last Wednesday. The suspects later demanded \$80,000 as well as pieces of property in Mexico from the victim's wife, officials said.

Jenkins said Mendoza-Valdovinos was targeted because his brother, Gavino Mendoza-Valdovinos, allegedly owes a large sum of money to drug dealers in Mexico. Gavino Mendoza-Valdovinos lost the money and drugs when he was arrested a year ago in Nash County on a narcotics violation. He remains incarcerated in Greene County.

Authorities said they are continuing to search for at least two additional suspects in the kidnapping.

Man accused of attempted rape freed after girl returns to Mexico

A Brunswick County man arrested last year for allegedly trying to rape a 12-year-old is free because the girl accusing him has returned to Mexico. Assistant District Attorney Meredith Everhart last week dropped the charges against **Virginio Colin Isidoro** of attempted first degree rape, taking indecent liberties with a child and felony disseminate obscenity.

He was then set free after spending a little more than six months in the Brunswick County Jail. The 37-year-old was arrested Sept. 24 after the girl said he tried to rape her last summer near the railroad tracks in Boiling Spring Lakes before she was able to fight him off.

The girl's testimony was the state's only evidence in the trial that was supposed to start this week, Everhart said.

But last week as she was gearing up for the trial, Everhart found out from the girl's family that she had gone back to Mexico with her sister and mother. Since there was no physical evidence or witnesses, the charges were dropped. "We didn't have any choice but to dismiss it," Everhart said.

The girl, who was in the seventh grade at the time of the alleged incident, was in the country illegally. But Everhart could have helped her obtain a "U Visa," which is good for up to four years for cooperating with law enforcement.

Isidoro, also from Mexico, was living in Winnabow at the time of the alleged incident. Everhart said they did not know Isidoro's legal status in the United States.

Keeping Isidoro in jail as he awaited trial cost around \$68 a day or approximately \$13,600, according to Charlie Miller, chief deputy for the Brunswick County Sheriff's Office.
