A Benson man will spend up to 2-1/2 years in prison after his conviction this week to trafficking marijuana and drug conspiracy charges. **Jose Agel Molina**, 51, was one of four family members arrested following a drug raid in May 2009 at a home at 7395-A Elevation Road near Highway 50 North.

Aided by the SBI, the Johnston County Sheriff's Office narcotics division seized 15 pounds of marijuana wrapped in four packages stuffed in a soft drink vending machine in a garage beside the home. Deputies also located a four-wheeler behind the home that had been reported stolen in 2005.

At the time of the drug bust, Sheriff Narcotics Captain A.C. Fish said, "Citizens of Johnston County should not wonder where our large quantities of drugs are coming from. Most of our trafficking charges in controlled substances leads back to Hispanic organizations." Agents estimate the drugs seized had a street value of \$22,500. In addition to his 25 to 30 month prison term, Molino was also fined \$10,000.

FBI nabs 4 in heroin case

The FBI arrested four people Thursday morning and charged them with trafficking heroin in Mecklenburg and Gaston counties. Two other suspects are being sought by authorities in the case.

Federal officials say the arrests are part of an ongoing investigation, Operation Dirty Girl 3, being conducted by federal, state and local officials, including the Charlotte-Mecklenburg and Gastonia police departments. Several other arrests in the case were made in June and July.

According to court documents, the heroin allegedly was received from Mexico and then delivered through a system which involved ring members working as dispatchers and delivery people. The six arrested Thursday morning have initial court hearings Monday.

Those arrested, according to the FBI, were:

- **Wilfredo Andujar** (also known as Rolando Casanova), 44, whose home is listed as Puerto Rico but is a Charlotte resident, according to Mecklenburg County jail records.
- James Lee Thompson, 46, of Gastonia.
- Anthony Britt Moore, 39, of Gastonia.
- **Irvin Josue Navarro Ramirez** (also known as Jorge), 25, whose home is listed as Mexico but is a Charlotte resident, according to Mecklenburg County jail records.

A fifth suspect, Nancy Tebbe Rotolo, 52, whose hometown is not known, is being held by local authorities, although the FBI did not say where. The sixth suspect, 24-year-old **Sergio Rosas Garcia**, known as "Bossman," is at large. He is from Mexico, federal officials say.

NC man gets 7 years for impersonating officer

RALEIGH, N.C. (AP) - An **illegal Mexican** immigrant living in North Carolina has been sentenced to seven years in prison after authorities say he impersonated a Customs Border Patrol officer and tricked illegal immigrants into paying him for proper documentation.

Prosecutors say **Roberto Diosdado-Star** wore a Customs Border Patrol uniform that included a badge, hat and Homeland Security shield.

Authorities say Diosdado-Star collected more than \$200,000 from Hispanic individuals seeking legal documentation for themselves or family members and used the money to buy several vehicles and a house in Raleigh.

Diosdado-Star pleaded guilty to visa fraud and illegal re-entry in February and was sentenced Thursday.

Hispanics in crashes lead DWI stats

Hispanic drivers involved in motor vehicle crashes are more likely to be intoxicated than members of other ethnic and racial groups, according to statistics compiled by state researchers.

The study by the Highway Safety Research Center at the University of North Carolina-Chapel Hill was based on information from law enforcement agencies. It states that **7.04 percent of Hispanic drivers involved in crashes in 2005 were intoxicated**, compared with 4.87 percent of Native Americans, 2.82 percent of whites and 2.28 percent of blacks.

Hispanics "are more likely on average to be suspected of drinking in crashes that police officers investigate," research center database specialist Eric Rodgman said.

Cultural differences and limited knowledge of U.S. laws might be driving the trend, law enforcement officials and community leaders said. Efforts are being made to develop education programs in the wake of recent high-profile fatal crashes.

Vehicle crashes are the leading cause of death for all Hispanics living in North Carolina. Many come from countries where enforcement of drinking and driving laws is lax. "They're just not aware of the laws that exist here. It's a big problem," said Lucy Vasquez, executive director of Amigos Internacional, a Hispanic outreach organization.

Feds charge more than 100 in drug roundup

Federal and local agents have charged more than 100 people on federal drug, weapon and **immigration violations** in what they called a vast conspiracy, authorities said Tuesday.

U.S. Attorney Walt Wilkins announced more than 50 arrests had been made as of Tuesday afternoon, with those involved tied to **Mexican drug suppliers** connected to "cells" of drug dealers and gangs in Atlanta, Charlotte and **Raleigh, N.C**

All 108 individuals named in the six federal indictments were charged. Eleven of those arrested are **illegal aliens from Mexico**, he added.

The investigation began in September, with undercover agents using wiretaps to make made numerous crack cocaine purchases. Wilkins said agents seized 33 firearms, about \$568,000 in cash, 18 kilograms of cocaine and six pounds of marijuana.

Each of those charged will face a mandatory minimum of 10 years in prison and a maximum of life in prison, the U.S. attorney said. Wilkins said he expected the prosecutions to move forward quickly, despite the complexity. Many will face higher penalties because of prior felony drug convictions, Wilkins said.

RALEIGH - Five illegal immigrants living in Columbus County were found guilty Monday of federal drug, firearms and immigration charges.

Sheriff's offices in Columbus, Bladen and New Hanover counties arranged for a cocaine buy from Lorenzo Jaimes-Cruz in March 2008. Once the drug deal took place and officers stopped the seller's vehicle, the driver was identified as Cavillo-Rojas. Lorenzo Jaimes-Cruz then arrived with four other men.

Investigators searched a home and found packaging equipment and six firearms. Another man, **John Carols Mendoza**, pleaded guilty to conspiracy and drug charges in December.

Fredy Jaimes-Cruz also was found guilty of eluding immigration officers, the release said. The other defendants pleaded guilty to that charge prior to trial.
