GREENSBORO — Police charged a Greensboro man Tuesday in connection with several sex crimes involving a child, according to arrest warrants.

Police charged **Jose Manuel Angel-Salazar**, 40, of 210 Woodnell St., Apt. H, in connection with a sexual assault of [a girl younger than 13](#) that happened on Tuesday, according to the warrants.

Angel-Salazar faces [charges of first-degree rape, second-degree kidnapping and taking liberties with a child.](#)

Angel-Salazar confined the girl “[for the purpose of terrorizing the victim,](#)” according to the warrants.

Angel-Salazar is held in the Guilford County jail on \$250,000 bond.

Investigators interviewed the children at the Dove House Children’s Advocacy Center in Statesville.

RALEIGH, N.C. — A 25-year-old man is facing charges in connection with the sexual assault of a child, the Raleigh Police Department said Saturday.

Leonardo Miranda Garcia, of 2311 Torquay Crossing in Raleigh, is charged with sex offense of a child and taking indecent liberties with a child.

The arrest warrant indicates the alleged crimes happened Friday, but it did not say how he knew the child.

Garcia was in the Wake County Detention Center under a \$2 million bond, according to police.

Drug Suspect Charged With Sexually Exploiting Minor

New felony sex charges have been levied against an illegal immigrant and suspected drug trafficker who has been behind bars since mid-October.

Hector Fuentes Gonzalez, 54, of West Church Street, Angier, was arrested Oct. 17 on felony cocaine trafficking charges.

Thanks to an extensive investigation by local and federal agents, he has been implicated on charges of sexually exploiting a 13-year-old girl.

Harnett County Sheriff's officials have formally charged the suspect with three felony counts of second-degree sexual exploitation of a minor and one felonious count of taking indecent liberties with a minor.

The subsequent sex charges tacked on Tuesday stem from an investigation that ensued following his arrest Oct. 17 inside the suspect's residence.

Agents from the Harnett County Sheriff's Office's Narcotics Division, along with agents from Homeland Security and officials from the Angier Police Department, executed a search warrant at the West Church Street residence. An electronic device belonging to the suspect was seized during the execution. Reports indicate images captured on the device implicated the suspect.

Sheriff's Detective Brad Byrd discovered nude images of an unknown female.

After an extensive investigation, Detective Byrd — a member of the national U.S. Department of Justice's organization, Internet Crimes Against Children Task Force — discovered the girl was only 13 years of age.

It has since been determined that Gonzalez is an illegal immigrant.

Man, 28 Charged After Sexual Relationship With Teen Girl Discovered

CHARLOTTE, N.C. - Police in Charlotte are investigating after **a 13-year-old girl** accused a Charlotte man, more than twice her age, of having a sexual relationship with her.

According to a search warrant released by the Charlotte-Mecklenburg Police Department, officers were called to a home on November 23 when a young girl returned home from a night out.

The girl, 13, reportedly refused to tell her parents where she had been the previous night.

When police showed up, the young girl admitted she had spent the night at the home of a 28-year-old man, with whom she has been in a year-long sexual relationship.

The young girl described the inside of **Jonathan Rubio**'s English Hills Drive apartment to officers, according to the warrant, including his bedroom.

She was then taken to a Charlotte-area hospital, by her parents, for treatment and a sexual assault kit.

Officers interviewed Rubio who said he spent the previous night with his roommate.

According to the warrant, his roommate didn't have the same story and told officers he hadn't seen Rubio most of the night.

When questioned about the girl's story about an alleged sexual relationship, Rubio wanted to leave the interview, the warrant states.

He was arrested and charged with statutory rape and indecent liberties with a child.

Rubio is currently being held in the Mecklenburg County Jail under a \$75,000 bond and a detainer from the U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement.

Man sentenced in Hickory sex case involving child

A Caldwell County man was sentenced to prison and will have lifetime status as **a registered sex offender following a conviction this week on rape charges involving a child**, authorities say.

Elmer Edgardo Flores, 21, of Granite Falls, was convicted in a Catawba County court of first-degree rape, first-degree sex offense with a child, and indecent liberties with a child.

The charges were in connection with events that took place last February in Hickory **and involved a girl under the age of 12, prosecutors say.**

Flores was sentenced to between 12 years and 19 years in prison. He also will be subject to lifetime satellite monitoring, prosecutors say.

15-year-old kidnapped girl found safe

A 15-year-old Montgomery County girl has been found safe in Alabama, and a man has been arrested in the case, according to authorities in Charlotte.

The girl was reported missing from her home in Troy, about 60 miles northeast of Charlotte, on Saturday.

The FBI office in Charlotte said its agents and the Montgomery County Sheriff's Office developed leads which pointed them to Alabama.

FBI agents from the Birmingham office and members of the Decatur, Ala., Police Department found the girl about 3:30 p.m. Tuesday in Decatur, the FBI said. A man, identified as **Jose Louis Resendiz**, 31, was arrested at the same time.

Shelley Lynch, a spokeswoman for the FBI in Charlotte, said **Resendiz is facing state charges including abduction of a child and second-degree kidnapping**. She said Resendiz eventually will be extradited to North Carolina.

The victim is in protective custody until she is reunited with her family, Lynch said.

Durham deputies ID person of interest in murder

DURHAM, N.C. (WTVD) -- The Durham County Sheriff's Office said Monday it wants to speak with a person of interest in the shooting death of a man earlier this month.

Saul Botello Abrimz, 31, was found shot to death at a home 200 block of Andrews Chapel Road - a rural area between Raleigh and Durham - on December 11.

Now, investigators are **looking for 33-year-old Alex Antonio Cruz Alvarado (AKA: Alex Lainez) in the case. Deputies said he's also wanted for auto theft and may be driving a stolen white 2000 Mitsubishi Montero Sport with N.C. license plate BMP-3978.**

Anyone with information about Alvarado's whereabouts is asked to call Durham CrimeStoppers at (919) 683-1200 or the Sheriff's Crime Tip Line at (919) 560-7151. CrimeStoppers pays cash rewards for information leading to the arrest of persons wanted in felony crimes and callers never have to identify themselves.

Wilson's Mills Man Convicted Of Murdering Wife

A Johnston County man has been sentenced to life in prison following the deadly shooting of his wife and the wounding of his stepfather in the Brogden community three years ago.

Jurors deliberated two days before returning a guilty verdict Thursday to first-degree murder, discharging a firearm into occupied property, and breaking and entering against **Adolfo Reyes Maldonado** of Wilson's Mills.

In July 2010, Maldonado went to a home on Neuse Bend Road, east of Smithfield where he shot and killed his wife, 28 year-old Elizabeth Reyes, then allegedly wound her stepfather, Ben Croft, who was shot once in the arm and leg. Croft managed to flee out of a window of the home and summon help from a neighbor. The couple's child, who was 11 months old at the time, was found at the scene. He was not injured.

Maldonado was sentenced to life in prison without the possibility of parole. The same jury that convicted the 48 year-old former construction worker in the death of his wife, found him not guilty of attempted first-degree murder and assault with a deadly weapon in the shooting of his father-in-law.

Authorities said the shooting was domestic related. Reyes had been living apart from her husband. She had obtained a restraining order against Maldonado on March 8, 2010 but the order was cancelled on March 19, 2010 when she failed to show up for a court hearing.

Reyes wrote in the domestic violence protection, four months before her death, "...the defendant struck me closed fist in the face and threatened me with jumper cables hitting hard on the grill. Saying come on b***h come get me."

Durham deputies ID body in suspected drug-related homicide

DURHAM — A man found dead in a Durham County home apparently suffered multiple gunshot wounds, and sheriff's investigators think he was the victim of a drug-related homicide.

The man, **Saul Botello Abrinz**, 31, was found at about 6:25 p.m. Wednesday in his home at 212 Andrews Chapel Road, just north of the Brier Creek area.

Investigators identified him after the help of the Mexican consulate in Raleigh.

Moore County Sheriff's Office makes arrest in shooting from 2006

More than seven years after a Moore County shooting, the Sheriff's Office has a suspect in custody.

Sheriff Neil Godfrey said investigators arrested **Rafael Martinez Anaya**, 43, of Burlington, Wednesday after he was returned from California.

Anaya was **charged with assault with a deadly weapon with intent to kill inflicting serious injury in the Sept. 7, 2006, shooting of Jose Uribe Ramirez.**

Moore County Sheriff's Office investigators found Ramirez shot in the face, arm and chest off Fawnwood Drive in Seven Lakes. He was treated at FirstHealth Moore Regional Hospital and survived the assault.

After a joint investigation between the Sheriff's Office and Aberdeen police, warrants were issued for Anaya in December 2006 and January 2007, but law enforcement was unable to locate him in North Carolina.

According to Godfrey, Los Angeles police officers arrested Anaya as a fugitive from justice on Nov. 8 when they discovered during a traffic stop that he was wanted in North Carolina.

Anaya was returned to North Carolina on Wednesday, when he was charged in the assault as well as with extortion. He is being held at the Moore County Detention Center with bail set at \$600,000.

Man accused of causing deadly crash rejects plea deal

CHARLOTTE, N.C. — **Uriel Flores** rejected a plea deal from the district attorney Thursday in connection with the deadly Sept. 18 crash on Sharon Road West.

The district attorney offered Flores a plea deal of **two counts of misdemeanor death by vehicle**, which would mean two consecutive 60-day sentences.

Flores will now go to trial to face charges of involuntary manslaughter, assault with a deadly weapon, three counts of inflicting serious injury, and felony hit-and-run.

If he is found guilty, he could spend more than eight years in prison.

Police said speeding was **involved in the Sept. 18 accident which killed Shanquise Bush and a 3-year-old boy in her car**, police said.

Witnesses said they saw Flores' white pickup move into Bush's lane and she overcorrected, slamming into a power pole.

9 arrested in multicounty meth ring, authorities say

Nine suspected members of a methamphetamine ring that operated in several Western North Carolina counties were arrested Tuesday, according to federal authorities, who are seeking three more men in the case.

The arrests followed an investigation by nearly a dozen local, county, state and federal law enforcement agencies.

According to the federal criminal indictment unsealed last week in U.S. District Court, **the suspects conspired to possess with intent to distribute more than 50 grams of meth or more than 500 grams of a mixed substance containing meth.**

Federal papers indicate most of the meth distribution and sales activity took place in Cleveland, McDowell and Buncombe counties. But the investigation also involved officials from Rutherford and Yancey counties.

Also involved were the N.C. Highway Patrol, the SBI, the S.C. Law Enforcement Division, agencies in Spartanburg County, the Drug Enforcement Administration and the U.S. Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives.

Federal officials say these nine people were arrested Tuesday (in most cases, the suspects face multiple counts of drug possession):

- George Wade “Rooster” Cook, 52, Casar – narcotics conspiracy; possession with intent to distribute a controlled substance.
- Gregory Ray DeHart, 44, Marion – narcotics conspiracy; distribution of a controlled substance; possession with intent to distribute a controlled substance.
- John Matthew “Ghost” Frady, 39, Cowpens, S.C. – narcotics conspiracy; possession with intent to distribute a controlled substance; felon in possession of firearms.
- Jeffrey Kirkland, 41, Gainesville, Ga. – narcotics conspiracy; possession with intent to distribute a controlled substance.
- Ramona Jamison Lail, 48, Marion – narcotics conspiracy; possession with intent to distribute a controlled substance.
- Jimmy Dwayne Lawing, 45, Marion – narcotics conspiracy; possession with intent to distribute a controlled substance.
- **Carlos Alvarado “Tequila” Mendoza**, 39, Candler – narcotics conspiracy; possession with intent to distribute a controlled substance.

- John Louis Pivonka, 42, Marion – narcotics conspiracy; possession with intent to distribute a controlled substance.
- Tommy Ray Sisk, 56, Old Fort – narcotics conspiracy; possession with intent to distribute a controlled substance.

These three men are being sought, authorities say:

A man posing as a high-ranking official with the United Nations was arrested Friday, after Charlotte-Mecklenburg police said he planned to take thousands of dollars under false pretense.

Kenly Funeral Home Loses License

After state investigators found a decomposing body in the Community Funeral Home of Kenly, it revoked its license and said that its principal owner engaged in the unlicensed practice of a funeral service.

Community Funeral Service operated for about a year in the building that was formerly the office of the late physician Carl C. Sox, two doors down from Kenly Town Hall on Second Street.

Investigators, according to information supplied by the state Board of Funeral Service, were notified that water service had been disconnected to the funeral home.

When investigators arrived, according to information from the state board, they found the decomposing body of a Mexican male.

The man who died had been placed with the funeral home for transport to Mexico by the Mexican Consulate.

The investigators, when they arrived at the funeral home, said “they noted both visual and olfactory evidence of decomposition” of the body “despite being embalmed.”

In addition to revoking Community Funeral Home of Kenly’s license, the board also “shall indefinitely refuse to issue or renew a funeral establishment permit...and to any funeral establishment in which its corporate officers and directors hold any financial, managerial, equity, employment or other interest.”

Further, the board decreed that Hugert Staggers Jr., identified as the president of the funeral home, shall be ineligible to apply for a traineeship in funeral directing, funeral service or embalming until May 1, 2014.

In its finding of fact, the board found that the funeral home, by and through its unlicensed owners, agents and employees knowingly made a false statement to Lester Sandlin to place on the death certificate of **Jose Toledo-Villalobos** that Mary Brand was the funeral director for his funeral.

Brand was identified as the chairman of the funeral home’s board of directors and manager of the funeral home.

The board found that she was never contacted to make or conduct the final disposition of Toledo-Villalobos.

In its conclusion of law, the board found that the funeral home failed to treat the dead body with respect at all times.

And, the board found, the facility was unattended at the time of inspection, had inadequate climate control or refrigeration to store human remains and did not have running water from the town of Kenly during the period the remains were stored.

“The handling of the remains...by the unlicensed owners and agents...contributed to the condition of the remains.”

MS-13 Gang Member Charged With Murder

A Forsyth County judge denied a motion Tuesday to reduce the bond for a Winston-Salem man who prosecutors say kicked a 19-year-old man in the head after he had been shot five times, including a fatal shot through the heart.

Shah'd Suliamon Clark, 28, of 545 N. Martin Luther King Jr. Drive, Apt. 3, is charged with first-degree murder and conspiracy to commit murder in connection with the fatal shooting of Anthony Person on Dec. 9, 2012.

Victor Angel Ortiz, 31, of 1852 Longview Drive is also charged with first-degree murder, and prosecutors say Ortiz is the one who pulled the trigger.

Ortiz and Clark were indicted on first-degree murder in October, and Clark had been in the Forsyth County Jail on a \$750,000 bond. His attorney, Lisa Costner, filed a motion to reduce the bond to \$200,000.

But Assistant District Attorneys Jonathan Friel and Derek Gray filed a motion in response, asking a judge to increase Clark's bond to \$1 million.

Judge Patrice Hinnant of Forsyth Superior Court rejected Costner's motion and ordered that Clark's bond be increased to \$1 million.

Friel said that Clark is a leader in the United Blood Nation gang and has a history of violence, including a 2006 conviction of assault with a deadly weapon inflicting serious injury in which Clark was accused of shooting another man in the arm and head. Friel said that at the time of the shooting Clark was on probation for an assault with a female stemming from an incident involving his girlfriend. Friel also said Clark has been charged in the past with carrying a concealed weapon.

Costner said Clark denies that he was ever in a gang and objected to Friel's characterization of Clark as a gang member without offering any evidence.

"That's a pretty loaded term to throw out in court," she said.

Friel said that numerous witnesses have described Clark as a gang member and that the Winston-Salem Police Department has determined he is a validated gang member.

According to Friel, the shooting stemmed from an earlier confrontation between Person and his friends with Clark and his friends. Friel said that Clark and Person were in rival gangs and that after the fight, Clark recruited [Ortiz, a member of the gang MS-13](#), to get back at Person.

The fight happened at Citgo gas station on Old Walkertown Road, less than one-half mile from Person's house. Friel said Clark and Ortiz went to Person's house, found out he wasn't there, circled around and came back when Person returned home.

Ortiz shot Person five times as he got out of the car, Friel said. After the shooting, Clark got out of the car and kicked Person in the head, Friel said.

Person was later taken to Wake Forest Baptist Medical Center, where he died.

Costner said Clark denies that he kicked Person in the head and that he knew Ortiz was going to shoot Person.

Costner disputed that Clark was dangerous and said that Clark has a strong family support system. She also said that he has a long work history and that he was attending Forsyth Technical Community College, taking classes for a business degree.

Friel said that one of the reasons he asked for a higher bond was concern that other members of Clark's gang might try to intimidate Person's family or other witnesses. He said prosecutors have had trouble with one witness because he fears that Clark's gang will retaliate against him.

Michael Person, father of Anthony Person, said that his 11-year-old daughter keeps her lights on in her bedroom at night because she is afraid.

"My family ... they're still afraid to go outside," he said.

Clark's next court hearing is Jan. 27 in Forsyth Superior Court. Ortiz is being held in Forsyth County Jail with no bond allowed on the first-degree murder charge. He is also scheduled to appear in Forsyth Superior Court on Jan. 27.

Police: Agitators in Crowd Disrupted Durham Vigil

DURHAM, N.C. — Police Chief Jose Lopez said Friday that his officers acted with "a whole lot of restraint" in using tear gas and riot gear to break up what began as a peaceful vigil in downtown Durham Thursday night to remember a teen who died in police custody last month.

Lopez said agitators in the crowd of about 200 arrived wearing masks, passed out fliers instructing people to be destructive and later hurled rocks and bottles at police.

"We knew there were individuals within that group that did not have peaceful intent," the chief said during a news conference.

Jesus "Chuy" Huerta, 17, was picked up on Nov. 19 on an outstanding second-degree trespassing charge from July. Police said he shot himself in the head after he had been searched, handcuffed and placed in a patrol car.

Lopez said tests conducted by the State Bureau of Investigation showed that Huerta had gunshot residue on gloves he was wearing, but no gunshot residue was found on the hands of Officer Samuel Duncan.

"The chief asks us to trust when he provides no way for us to verify his claims," Alexander Charns, an attorney for Huerta's family, said in a statement.

Charns said the family wants to see the gloves and review the test results to determine if the gloves even belonged to Huerta. He added that Durham police have never said how the gun ended up in the patrol car. Since Huerta's death, his friends and family members have demanded a federal investigation into the Durham Police Department about his death and possible "patterns and practices" of civil rights violations within the department.

Mayor Bill Bell said late Friday that the police department should release the findings of its internal investigation into Huerta's death, adding, "if they don't choose to release it, I would like to know why."

In a separate statement issued through Charns, the family blasted the police response to the vigil. "Why would (Lopez) send riot police out against a grieving mother holding a flower and candle for her dead son? She was threatened with arrest along with the rest of the family," the statement said. "He sent troops in battle regalia against people holding Our Lady of Guadalupe candles and signs asking for justice. But he can't stop prayers with force, and he can't stop the truth from coming out. In a surprising admission, police headquarters was surrounded by crime scene tape last night."

The vigil began with candlelight, signs and flowers. Gradually it got louder, with participants shouting obscenities to the beat of a drum as they marched from CCB Plaza to the police headquarters, where the crowd was told to disperse.

The group then reversed course and headed back to CCB Plaza. Lopez said that's when acts of vandalism started occurring and his officers came under attack.

The officers used "best law enforcement practices" to disperse the crowd with minimal injuries and property damage, he said. Six people were arrested:

- **Andy Guadalupe Mendoza**, 18, of 1229 Berkeley St., charged with failure to disperse on command and resisting law enforcement
- **Gustavo Pascual Gutierrez**, 22, of 2008 Angier Ave., charged with one count of trespassing at police headquarters.
- Benjamin Colt Markgraf, 20, of 10712 Rougemont Road, charged with carrying a concealed weapon, disorderly conduct and impeding traffic.
- **Vianey Fuentes**, 17, of Great Bend Drive, charged with failure to disperse on command and resisting law enforcement.
- **Perla Eliza Fuentes**, 16, of Tremont Drive, charged with failure to disperse on command and resisting law enforcement.
- A 15-year-old juvenile female. No information was released on her charges.

Mendoza said Friday that he was at the vigil simply to support the Huerta family.

"We did not expect what happened last night, but yeah, we sort of accomplished what we wanted to. We wanted to show support," he said. "We basically wanted to show that Chuy will never be forgotten."

Other Durham residents who don't even know the family gathered outside police headquarters Friday to support the teen's mother as well.

"I really can't imagine, as a mother of two boys, what her heart feels and to want to be public with her prayer for peace, for answers to her questions," Omisade Burney said. "Durham should be a harm-free zone. Durham should be a safe place for all of our children."

A similar vigil held three days after Huerta's death also turned violent, and Lopez said he wanted to avoid a repeat of that. Unfortunately, he said, people within Thursday night's crowd had other intentions.

"It was supposed to be a peaceful march," he said. "The peaceful intent did not exist prior to and did not exist at that point in time when you start to look at the individuals that were there and the message that they were sending."

Police collected materials handed out during the protest that showed some in the crowd were "teaching others to engage in a destructive, aggressive and assaulting manner." Lopez said.

The agitators put people at more risk by throwing objects than police officers did by using tear gas and breaking up the crowd, he said. A baseball-sized rock hit one officer on a face shield, he said, and one protester suffered a minor injury.

"Nobody is happy about what happened," City Manager Tom Bonfield said, adding that he understands the police department's actions.

"It's difficult to second-guess their decisions about that. There are tactical decisions, tactical decisions that occur that they have to make instantaneous decisions about," Bonfield said. "I'm very confident that the officers that were involved were well trained and well prepared for circumstances."

Alamance County deputies are looking for a suspect who fled the scene after shooting and killing a man in a mobile home park Sunday.

A man has been charged following a shooting the day after Christmas in Caswell County.

The victim was transported to Danville Regional Medical Center and then air-lifted to Bowman Grey Hospital for treatment.
